SAR Eagle Scout Certificate Available anytime

- Upon request, the Colorado Society of SAR (cossar.us) provides a Certificate of Recognition to a scout who earns the rank of Eagle Scout. Email your request to the State or Chapter Eagle Scout Chair with the Eagle Scout's name, address, and date of Eagle Scout Court of Honor. Report any name misspelling as quickly as possible.
- The SAR address for Eagle Scout certificates listed on such sites as <http://usscouts.org/eagle/eaglecongrats.asp> is also correct and may be used; however there is a substantial delay as that request is forwarded from the SAR national headquarters to the state chair for certificate distribution.

Application:

Eagle Scouts should submit their application to their Chapter chairs. The application and other information can be found at: www.sar.org/Youth/Eagle_Scout, and the forms printed from this site must accompany the application. The applicant should be submitted to you chapter chair. There are four SAR chapters in Colorado (email or call the State Chair in unable to contact):

Recognition:

- Each Eagle Scout submitting a qualified entry will receive the SAR Eagle Scout competition patch
- Each chapter winner, one per year, receives the SAR Eagle Scout medal
- The state winner, one per year, receives the SAR Eagle Scout trophy and \$250 intended for post high school education. Past state winners may be viewed at: <http://www.cossar.us/programsawards/eaglescoutaward.html>)
- The state winner's application is forwarded to the National SAR where the scholarship awards are much higher

Requirements:

1. You have to be an Eagle Scout, who is currently registered in an active unit, and have not reached your 19th birthday during the year of application.
2. Submit the completed two-page application with
 - A scout's Four Generation Ancestor Chart
 - An original 500 word essay on some aspect of the American Revolution (suggestions can be found on the sar.org web site).
3. Consideration on the application is also given for the amount of scouting and leadership activity, including:
 - a. Leadership in the troop, school, and community,
 - b. Scouting religious emblems,
 - c. Summer camps, High Adventure and large scale activity like Philmont, NYLT, Jamboree, etc
 - d. Number of merit badges, and if the scout has earned three elective merit badges consistent with the goals of SAR: American Heritage, Law and Genealogy.
4. There is no cost to enter and you do not have to be a SAR member.
